CLUBHOUSE OVERVIEW

Inspired by the richness and beauty of its desert mountain surroundings, the clubhouse of The Ritz-Carlton Golf Club, Dove Mountain provides panoramic views as it creates a luxurious yet authentic Arizona experience for club members and guests alike.

The geologic makeup of the Tortolita Mountains served as inspiration for the clubhouse architecture, with a variety of natural materials used to emphasize the structure's connection to the high-desert landscape. Stone and metal are two elements that are keys to the clubhouse design, with intricate steps taken to preserve the materials as closely as possible to their natural state.

Many design characteristics of the clubhouse allow it to harmonize with its environment. For example, both The Members Grill and Cayton's, The Ritz-Carlton Golf Club's signature restaurant, invite the desert to come inside, with wood-framed glass panels that unfold, opening out to exterior patios. The settings overlook the Jack Nicklaus Signature Design Golf Courses with the Tortolita Mountains as a backdrop.

Exterior lounge areas abound on all sides of the clubhouse, providing various options to enjoy the scenery and weather characteristic to the Tortolita Mountains area. There are two private dining areas, including the clubhouse Wine Room, where guests can enjoy the surrounding 1,500 bottles that are stored on site.

The covered, open-air Kiva Room is sure to be a preferred venue for parties, dinners and other special events. Towering stone walls surround the circular space that features a 30-foot steel-shrouded fireplace, colorful artwork and custom wrought-iron lanterns.

The clubhouse exterior features rough stone masonry, natural stucco and weathered steel that reflect the desert's many hues and textures. This celebration of Arizona's geology continues with an interior design that showcases natural quartzite floors, raw steel, copper, and artifacts, such as geodes and quartz crystal.

The rich local history of geology, gemology and jewelry artists inspired a variety of custom steel and copper chandeliers that rain down strands of raw, uncut semi-precious gemstones, such as quartz, citrine, turquoise, amethyst and carnelian. This scheme is repeated throughout the clubhouse, as vibrant accents among the more common neutrals of the desert palette.

Each area throughout the clubhouse has its own distinct furniture, finishes, lighting and color palette. This provides each space with a unique personality that is different from the rest of the spaces while maintaining unity throughout. The furniture is finely crafted and detailed, yet comfortable and inviting, their smooth but unpolished surfaces meeting The Ritz-Carlton quality standard, while reflecting the informality of the Southwest lifestyle.

There is a tactile quality to the design that encourages visitors to genuinely experience the space – to touch and feel, as desired – and notice of the details. Lounge areas feature natural stone fireplaces and chairs richly upholstered in leather and chenille, beckoning guests to sit down and relax.

The Members Grill and Cayton's each has its own bar, featuring leather bar stools, granite bar top, wood plank flooring, flat panel television set and tooled leather detailing on the bar front. The members' private facilities include separate men's and women's lounge areas and locker rooms, workout area, showers and steam room.

The men's lounge features a massive stone fireplace with three HDTV monitors surrounded by a large sofa, leather recliners and two game tables. The women's lounge provides a spa-like atmosphere, with soft colors and soft fabrics used for the large sectional sofa and pillows, and private patio for sunbathing or stargazing, complete with its own fireplace.

The many natural elements of the clubhouse at The Ritz-Carlton Golf Club, Dove Mountain create the authentic Arizona experience for which the Tucson area is known, complemented by the luxury in a relaxed and casual setting for members and resort guests alike.
