Vista Vallarta Jack Nicklaus Signature Golf Course, host site for the 2002 World Golf Championships- EMC World Cup, and the 2006 Puerto Vallarta Blue Agave Golf Classic Champions Tour Event

With over three million visitors each year, Puerto Vallarta has long been the gem of the Mexican Pacific resort coastline. It's legendary beauty,

Spread across 478 acres, the Vista Vallarta Club de Golf encompasses two 18-hole, Par-72 championship golf courses: the first is a Signature Golf Course Design by golf legend Jack Nicklaus, and the neighboring course is a Signature Course

Design by golf great Tom Weiskopf. Opened on April 1, 2001, the Jack Nicklaus Signature Golf Course is located on the property's highest elevation, offering breathtaking views of Puerto Vallarta, the Marina and the Banderas Bay, arguably the best shelter marina in Mexico. Grassy hillsides, dense forest of palm, giant ficas trees and natural creeks provide the setting for this world-class course.

Opened on November 1, 2001, the Tom Weiskopf Signature Course offers a dramatic contrast from the Jack Nicklaus Signature Golf Course. Located on the west-end of the Vallarta Vista property, the

golf course is built on extreme terrain with dense jungles, deep ravines and swift creeks. The course plays through towering forests of palms and papillae trees and across deep natural ravines and swift creeks that are characteristic of the properties lowest elevations. Weiskopf has done a masterful job of blending the elevations and natural features to create the ultimate golf experience. The holes are designed to suit every level of golfer on both courses, from amateurs to professionals.

The Club's services include complete practice facilities, and luxurious clubhouse with restaurant, bar and lounge, verandas, fully stocked golf shop, and on course beverage service.

In addition to the World Golf Championship, Vista Vallarta's championship courses have already drawn major golf tournaments to the region including the Champions Tour golf tournament which was established in 2006. It is played at the Vista Vallarta Club de Golf in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico over the Jack Nicklaus course. It is the only Champions Tour event in Mexico, and the richest golf tournament of any kind staged in the country in 2006, Morris Hatalsky won the first tournament, taking the winner's US\$250,000 share of the \$1.6 million purse. The Ford U.S. Collegiate Golf Championships which took place in 2001 2002 and 2003 and was televised on ESPN, the Taylor-Made Invitational held annually in November, the Puerto Vallarta Pro Am held annually in December; and the International Foundation for Junior Golf World Junior Golf Championships in August 2001.

Vista Vallarta Club de Golf is the focal point of a premier master-planned development that will include world-class hotels, spa, residences and time share properties.

Vista Vallarta Club de Golf, Marina Vallarta Club de Golf, Cozumel Country Club and Pok-Ta-Pok Club de Golf are owned and/or operated by ClubCorp International.
